2019 Annual Report

Produce, Produce, Produce!

We are most proud of the pantry's expanded distribution of fruits and vegetables: the pantry's produce usage has gone from 1,000 pounds per month in 2017, to 17,000 pounds in 2018, to 34,000 pounds per month in 2019. More than 200 tons of fresh produce was distributed in 2019. The Northside Food Pantry is the only Pantry in southwest PA that offers fresh produce to its clients on an unlimited, daily basis, with many of our neighbors returning several times a week for more fresh produce.

Recurring donors

In 2019, the Northside Food Pantry had 45 monthly recurring donors contributing an average of \$1,308 each month, or a total of \$15,691 for the year. In November, the Northside Food Pantry Advisors changed online giving platforms to allow for a more accountable and user-friendly experience for our supporters. Within six weeks, we had nearly 100% participation in our new recurring donor program and even generated four new donors. Recurring donors are the backbone of our giving efforts and allow for stability in income from month to month. Without you, our efforts would not be possible. Thank you!

Who we serve

The Northside Food Pantry is one of the largest pantries in Western Pennsylvania by number of households served, helping up to 1,000 families a month from Pittsburgh's Northside residing in the 15212, 15214 and 15233 zip codes.

In 2019, the pantry served 2,686 individuals from 1,761 households, which includes 881 children. Pantry usage by kids under 17 represents a 50% increase over the past two years while adult clientele is expanding at a rate of nearly 25% during the same time period. From 2017 to 2019, there has been a 62% increase in the number of new individuals accessing the Pantry.

In 2019, Friendsgiving raised \$2,500 for the Northside Food Pantry Advisors. A new addition in 2019 included the donation of a seasonal keg from Allegheny City Brewery.

In 2019, we received more than 200 separate Amazon orders worth more than \$5,000. One of the most popular items to buy continues to be heart-healthy Campbell's Chunky Chicken Noodle Soup, which goes for less than \$1.50/can when it's on special.

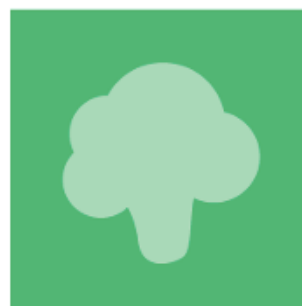


Our Elks Club

Every year, our Northside Elks Club supports the Northside Food Pantry with in-kind purchases worth \$10,000. This support offers our clients hard to come by items like household cleaning supplies (dish soap, multi-purpose cleaner) and personal care items (shampoo, hygiene products).

Looking ahead

The University of Pittsburgh's recent, "Pittsburgh's Inequality Across Gender and Race" report outlined something the Northside Food Pantry Advisors had been seeing anecdotally: our in-need neighbors require consistent access to wholesome foods to lead healthy lives. As such, on top of our 2020 food budget of \$30,000, we hope to raise \$10,000 to make 2020 our "Year of Greens." This will ensure that our neighbors have reliable, daily access to a leafy green vegetable, known as a primary fighter against heart disease.
