# 2020 Annual Report

#### COVID-19

Like every organization, the Northside Food Pantry drastically changed pantry operations in early March 2020. Thanks to the thoughtful preparation spearheaded by Pantry Coordinator Jana Thompson, there was no interruption in service. Pantry operations shifted to a curbside system quickly, and with the help of a dedicated army of in-person and at-home volunteers, orders were fulfilled within one hour on pantry shopping days.

What did change was the supply chain: we soon noticed that our donated produce would not be available in the same volume we needed. We developed a relationship with Consumer's Produce in the Strip District, and because of the generosity of donors, we were able to afford the \$18,000 produce bill.

Buying from Consumer's Produce means that pantry families have been able to access the same quality produce that is available at supermarkets. The pantry has become a reliable resource to our neighbors for healthy, store-quality produce. Consistent availability allows families to plan, eat well, and improve their health in what was a stressful year for all of us. We are the only pantry in southwest PA that offers fresh produce on an unlimited, daily basis, with many of our neighbors returning two or three times a week for more fresh and frozen produce.

The Northside Food Pantry and Northside Food Pantry Advisors changed in other ways during the COVID pandemic: curtailing volunteer opportunities and no longer accepting donations of food. Our curbside system requires us to have quantity, which is why we used more than \$3,000 from our financial supporters to purchase nearly 2200 cans of chunky soup in the last quarter of 2020. Your financial donations allow us to wait until the soup is discounted and available in a very large quantity to accommodate our new distribution model.

While we remain hopeful that the pantry will be able to safely re-open at some point in 2021 for inperson shopping, we are most proud of being able to maintain choice throughout the pandemic. No matter the circumstance, pantry families were able to place orders for the items they wanted to receive.







#### 2020 Service

2020 brought numerous service challenges on not only a monthly but also daily basis. From continually changing circumstances in the supply chain, to implementing improved safety systems, to construction outside the pantry doors, the Pantry Coordinator and volunteers continued to rise and conqueror these and many more 2020 challenges, again and again.

The Pantry distributed 327 tons of food sourced from the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank, with the heaviest hauls coming from meat and produce. Additionally, another 27 tons of fresh fruit and vegetables from Consumer's Produce gave a healthy supplement to the selection of food. In total, more than 350 tons of food was distributed in the 2020 calendar year.

#### Year of Greens

With limited exceptions, the Northside Food Pantry Advisors were able to purchase and offer customers unlimited access to frozen spinach throughout the year.

Our goal was to provide this leafy green vegetable, a known fighter against heart disease, to pantry families. The recent University of Pittsburgh, "Pittsburgh's Inequality Across Gender and Race" report outlined something the Northside Food Pantry Advisors had been seeing anecdotally: our in- need neighbors require consistent access to wholesome foods to lead healthy lives.

While COVID changed many things, it did not change access to the produce families were accustomed to seeing at the pantry, and we were grateful to be able to provide frozen spinach on a daily basis not only in 2020, but continuing forward into 2021.







## Bags!

If you are on our Northside Food Pantry Advisors email list, you have surely been notified about our need for bags. Our curbside ordering system requires stiffer bags to allow our fulfillment volunteers to more easily process orders, to permit the stacking of orders on our outdoor cart to put in customer trunks, and to provide an easier trip home for customers who travel on foot to the pantry.

We have easily exceeded 15,000 bags donated in 2020. While we cannot thank everyone who dropped off bags, we would like to note our organizational partners who provided volumes of bags at no cost to us:
